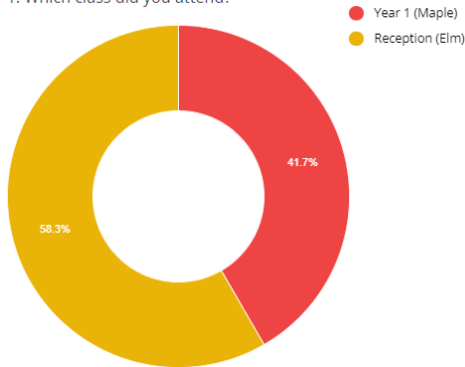


Reception and Year One Live Phonics Lessons for Parents – Parent Survey Results

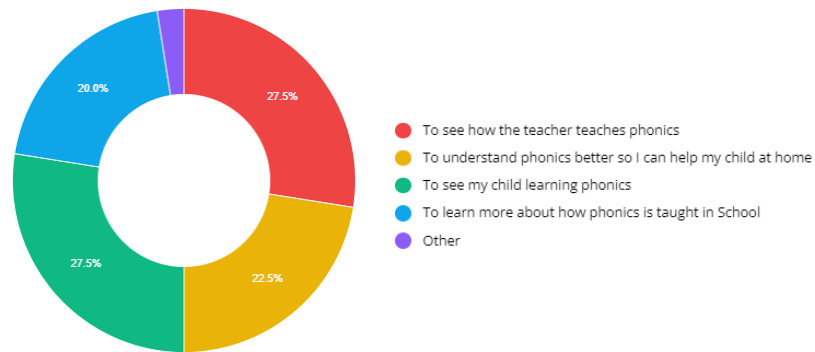
‘Working together to achieve success’

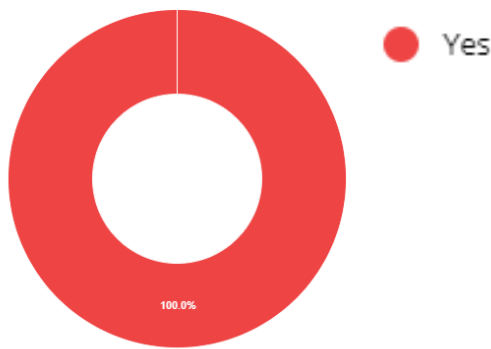
1. Which class did you attend?



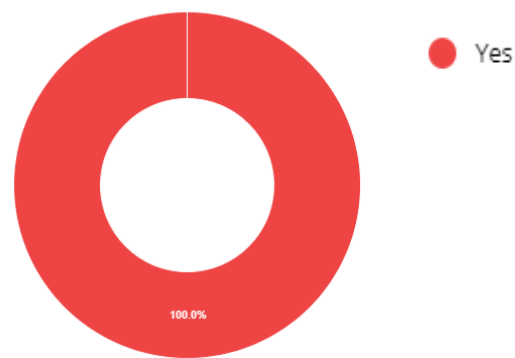
2. What was your reason for attending?



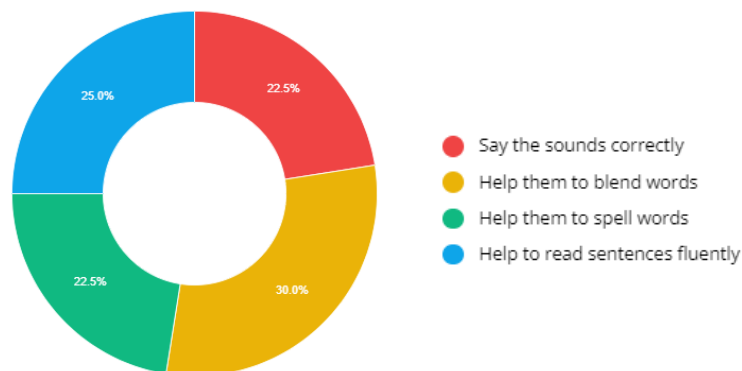
3. Did you find the lesson useful for you as a parent?
