Nursery Update

Before the Christmas break, we received approval from Lancashire County Council to apply for central government funding to open a school-based nursery. We have submitted our application to the Department for Education who will be reviewing the applications and notifying schools about their decision at some point this term. As soon as I find out more, I will provide you with an update.



National Changes to Unauthorised Absences

From September 2024, all schools in England have to follow the government's new attendance rules which I have summarised below. The main changes are that:

- 1. Schools now receive termly visits from the local authority to scrutinise their attendance data and the action they are taking to address persistently absent pupils attendance below 90%.
- 2. Schools should use legal interventions (which includes fines) to tackle absences caused by repeated holidays and / or when families do not engage in plans to support attendance and punctuality.

Fines, now referred to as legal interventions, have increased from £60 to £80, or £160 if not paid within 21 days, per parent per child. Legal interventions should be considered when a child has missed 10 sessions for unauthorised reasons in a rolling period of 10 school weeks which can span different terms or school years. (One session is half a day so a full day equals two sessions.) Unauthorised absences include:

- Holidays all holidays are unuathorised. If we suspect a family is on holiday, we will request evidence.
- Lateness children arriving at school after 8:55am. This is recorded as a half day absence.
- Persistent illness if a child has historical attendance concerns, we can request medical evidence before authorising absences for illness. For children with Health Care Plans, this will not be required.

Over the next two weeks, I will be writing to families where there is an ongoing attendance concern. If your child has had repeated absences for genuine medical reasons, please do not worry.

Extra-Curricular Clubs - Spring 2025

We are once again able to offer a wide range of extra-curricular activities after school. Please discuss club options with your child before signing them up using the School Spider app. Places are limited, so only choose a club that your child will commit to attending weekly. Clubs will run for a block of **8 weeks** across the **Spring term** starting w/c 13/01/25. **Clubs will not run the first and last week of each half term: w/c 06/01/25, 10/02/25, 24/02/25 and 31/03/25.** Dates when clubs do not run are included in the Diary Dates.

Due to the time taken for children to change, we ask that younger children do not change their clothes, but they can bring trainers. All children will be dismissed from the school hall. Please wait in the foyer. Texts will be sent to parents to confirm which club(s) your child has been allocated.

Earrings, Jewellery and Make-up

If your child has pierced ears, small stud earrings - not hoops, are allowed as part of our school uniform. On PE days, including Y5 swimming on a Friday, children should come to school with earrings removed to minimise the risk of injury from increased physical activity during PE / swimming lessons.

A polite reminder that no make-up, nail varnish, false nails, jewellery (including smart watches) or fashion statements (large hair bows etc) are allowed and children will be asked to remove these by their class teacher. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the school office to arrange to speak to me.

PE Kit Reminders

A reminder that on PE days, children need to wear our agreed PE Kit which forms part of our uniform.

- Mossgate sports top required
- Navy shorts required
- Slip on plimsolls with light coloured soles for indoor PE and trainers for outdoors - required
- Children in Reception do not need plimsolls, and will only need trainers in the summer term
- Navy blue tracksuit (please avoid hoods) will be needed when it is cold as children wear their PE kit to school on their PE days instead of their usual uniform - required
