Now wait and see the herbs shoot up!



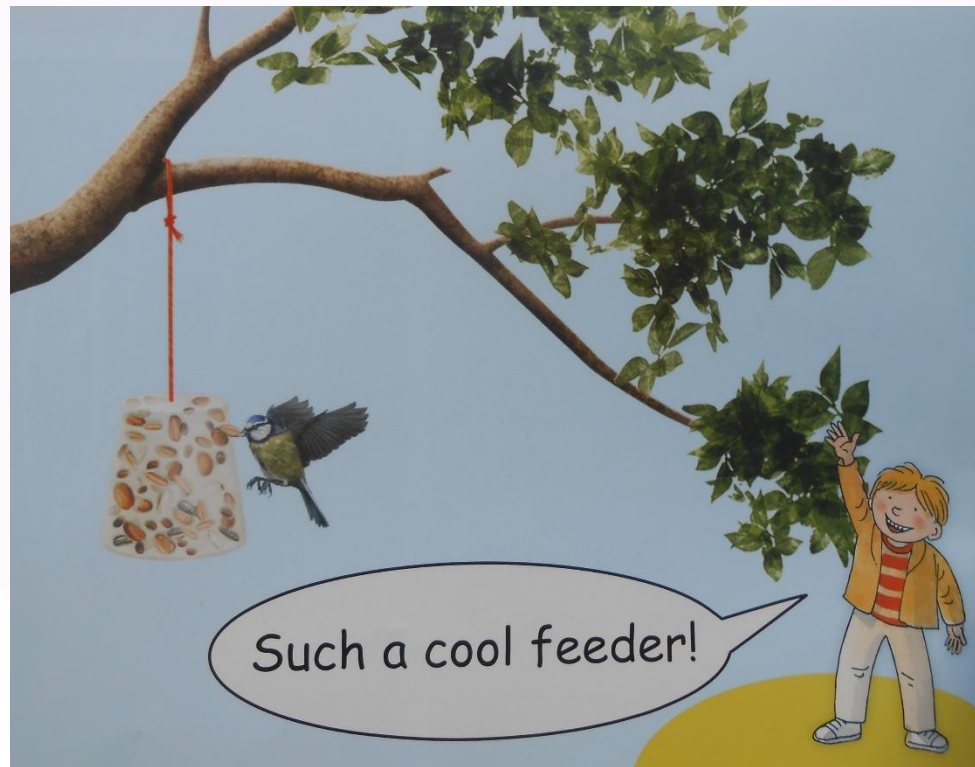

A feeder

You can hang a feeder in a tree. It needs to be up high.



For a feeder you will need:

a cup

nuts



seeds



lard or fat



wool to hang it up



How to set up a feeder

- 1 Mix the nuts and seeds. Get Mum or Dad to mix in the fat.



- 2 Hang the wool down in the cup.



- 3 Now add the mix to the cup.



- 4 Let it set, then hang it up in the garden.
